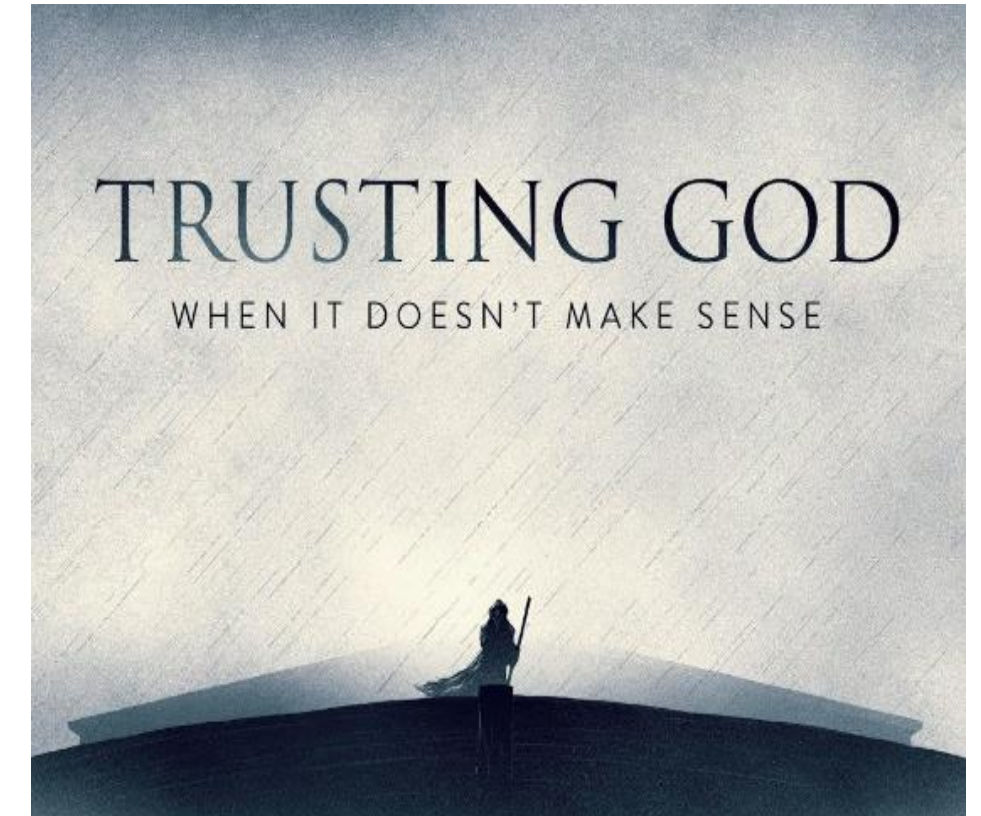

**MONMOUTH DAY CARE CENTER FOOD PANTRY** - Embury will now be supporting the food pantry at Monmouth Day Care Center in Red Bank. MDCC has been serving the community for 49 years. They are committed to the idea that regardless of race, religion or socio-economic background, all children have a fundamental right to quality education. They are licensed by the state and accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children. There are 120 children currently attending between the ages of 2 months and 5 years old. 90% of the families receive government subsidy. The pantry is offered to MDCC families and only during the Center's operating hours. It is also open one day a week to local VNA, WIC participants. Every item put on the shelf is taken within 24-48 hours, so there is an ongoing need for donations. All donations can be placed in the marked container in the Narthex. Our goal is to open up this outreach to the residents in our community with other drop-off locations. Details on this to follow.
